Entry Fee: \$5.00 per animal and copy of the registration paper for each animal must accompany entry.

Each exhibitor is to furnish his/her own shavings or straw and feed.
All hay should be in bales (kept neat).

110 – Purebred Holstein - District 1 Holstein Show
170 – Purebred Red and Whites

Judging – Wednesday, July 24th, 6:30 pm.

- These two breeds will show in one combined show. It will be a “pull-out” style show for the Red & Whites. Any Red & White wishing to show as part of the district show must sign the animal up as both D110 & D170, paying both premiums.
- Any youth wishing to show a grade Holstein may do so as long as the youth has a paid membership to MN Jr Holstein Association. For more info, contact superintendent.
- All exhibitors must have MN Holstein Assoc. dues paid at entry. This will be enforced.
- Premiere Breeder & Exhibitor shall be awarded.

All animals in these two classes should be brought in between 8:00AM and 5:00PM on Monday, July 22. Released after show on Wednesday, July 24.
