County Fair Flower Show Rules

See Introductory Rules to Horticulture Department Rules under Department 28.
Additional or revised rules for this department are as follows:

1. Design must be sole work of exhibitor.
2. Arrangements need to be made with live flowers and greens.
No dried or artificial flowers, fruits, or foliage may be used.
3. Noxious weeds such as and including purple loosestrife,
thistles, nightshade and Queen Anne's Lace are prohibited.

Also excluded are endangered plant materials such as and including wild orchids and wild lilies.

4. Bases and mats are allowed to be used in all arrangements.
5. Accessories are allowed but no natural birds' nests, stuffed birds, butterflies, insects, or animals are permitted.
6. Due to time and space limitations, assisted staging may be necessary. Except where noted, entries shall not exceed 24 inches in width.
7. Exhibitors are encouraged to enter multiple lots in their Class to make the show a success, but only one entry per lot.
8. Professional arrangements will be judged by MSHS standards.
