3. When completing your online entry, give as complete a description as possible, including color, size, shape, etc
4. Take your entries directly to the Aune Hall / 4-H Building, where you will receive entry tags.
5. **ENTRIES MUST BE THE ORIGINAL WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR AND COMPLETED WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS**
6. Exhibitors of collections should bring a case in which to display their hobby, it at all possible.
7. **NOTE: ALL COLLECTIONS OR WORK MUST NOT HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY EXHIBITED AT AN OLMSTED COUNTY FAIR**
8. The Hobby Division Superintendent reserves the right to screen entries and limit the size and quantity to fit available
9. The Fair Management will use diligence to help ensure the safety of articles in the exhibits; **HOWEVER, IN NO CASE WILL THEY BE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE THAT MAY OCCUR**
10. Entries open to any resident of Minnesota.
11. Hobbies may be sub-divided if the number of entries warrant.
12. All wall hangings must be ready to hang
13. **HAVE ALL SOILABLE MATERIAL COVERED WITH PLASTIC**
