RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1. There is a limit of one (1) entry per lot.**
- Entries will NOT be accepted after 7:00 pm on July 24, 2023
- All photographs must contain the entrant's name, address, phone number, title and class/lot on the back **lower right corner**
- Photographs plus mount size must not exceed 11"x14" or be smaller than 8"x10". The actual photograph should not be smaller than 5"x7".
- All photographs must be on a suitable backing (foamboard, poster board, tag board, matt) A clear plastic hanger tab must be mounted in the center of the photo mount, preferably the type with 1 hole. The only exception to this rule will be a Landscape picture that are at least 14" on their long side. NO framed pieces will be accepted. Do not use string as a hanger, or spray adhesive to attach the hanger.** These usually do not stay together and could result in your photo being damaged. If it falls apart, it will **not** be judged. The superintendent reserves the right to remove entries that fall apart during the fair.
- Photographs may not be over two years old.
- Entries must clearly fit in each lot. The judges reserve the right to reclassify photographs into appropriate lots.
- Computer images must be the sole work of the exhibitor and may not contain copyrighted materials other than that of the exhibitor. A brief description of how the image was produced should be included on the back of the photograph.
- Photographs not meeting rule requirements will not be judged or displayed**
- Judges reserve the right to award prizes as quantity and quality of photographs dictate. Judges' decisions are final.
- Photographs will be released and can be picked up at the display area after 4:00 pm until 6:00 pm on the final night of the fair, Sunday, July 30th.
- The Olmsted County Agricultural Association is not responsible for the lost or damaged entries
- Subject matter must be appropriate to all audiences

Entries are judged on Presentation, Creativity, Composition, Lighting and Focus.
